Session 6: Revival Through Representation

Scriptures:

- Acts 4:13 "When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished and took note that these men had been with Jesus."
- 2 Corinthians 3:2-3 "You yourselves are our letter, written on our hearts, known and read by everyone."

Focus:

Revival is not a one, time event, it's a lifestyle of carrying Jesus so clearly that others encounter Him through us.

You are a living epistle, written by God, read by the world.

When we embody His presence, it reshapes:

- How revival spreads (through lives, not just services)
- How people encounter God (through representation, not just proclamation)
- How transformation happens (through daily surrendered living)

Topic 1: Revival is Recognizable

Introduction:

True revival is recognizable, not because of marketing, but because of transformation. The evidence? Changed lives, not changed hashtags.

A. Being With Jesus Changes Us

- The world recognizes when someone has been with Jesus.
- Intimacy with Him imprints His character onto ours.

Scripture:

• Acts 4:13 "They took note that these men had been with Jesus."

Teaching Point:

You don't have to announce revival if you carry revival.

B. Revival is Seen, Not Just Preached

- Our lives are living testimonies.
- We don't just speak the message, we become the message.

Scripture:

• 2 Corinthians 3:2-3 "You yourselves are our letter... known and read by everyone."

Teaching Point:

People are reading your life before they listen to your words.

Visual Summary Flow:

Encounter → Transformation → Embodiment → Living Witness

Mini, Activation: Embody the Message

Step 1: Reflection

- Ask the Lord:
 - "Father, what message are people reading in my life right now?"
 - "Where are You inviting deeper alignment with Your heart?"

Step 2: Declarations

I am a living letter of Christ.

I carry His presence into every place I go.

I live revival, not just in moments, but in every day surrendered to Him.

Step 3: Group Discussion

Question:

Where has God used your life as a testimony, even without you saying a word?

Final Closing and Commissioning for Session 6

Landing Thought:

"Revival isn't just something we pray for, it's something we live.

When you walk out of here, you don't leave revival behind, you carry it forward."

Group Declarations:

We are ambassadors of the King.

We are living letters of His goodness.

We carry revival into homes, workplaces, neighborhoods, and nations.

We choose to live surrendered, shining, and set apart.

Revival lives in us, and through us it will touch the world.
