Big Themes that Flow Across All Sessions:

- **Identity before influence:** You must know where you belong before you can carry Kingdom impact.
 - **Transformation before representation:** Heaven's culture must form in you before it can flow through you.
 - **Presence before platform:** Deep roots in God produce lasting fruit for the world.
 - **Revival as a lifestyle, not an event:** Revival is not an event we visit—it's a reality we carry.

- A disciple being continually formed into Christ's likeness.
- A living letter, read by the world, reflecting the heart of God.
